Teams of four high school students will be compete against other high schools to test knowledge of this year's topics: NAFTA, ASEAN, India's Bid for Global Power, Combating Climate Change, Cybersecurity, Saudi Arabia, Great Decisions, Peacebuilding Toolkit, America's Diplomats, and Current Events.

The Indiana Council on World Affairs will award an expense paid trip for the winning team to compete in the national Academic WorldQuest competition, April 28, 2018, in Washington, D.C.

Last year, Indiana's team placed 6th in the highly competitive national competition pulling from winning teams of 1,000's of high school students from across the U.S.
